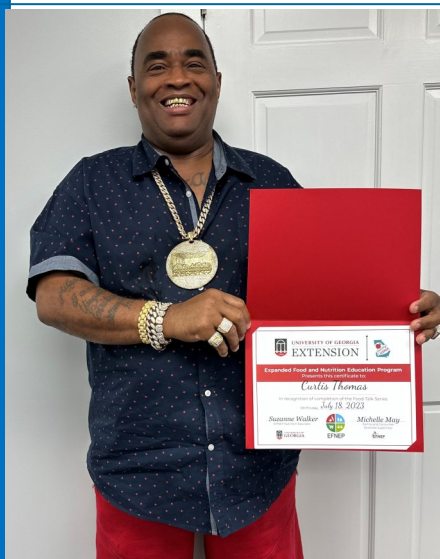
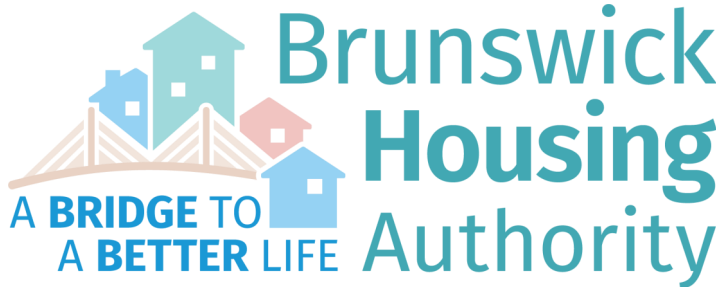

The Food Talk curriculum teaches participants how to stretch their food dollars, improve nutrition practices, and prevent food-borne illness.
