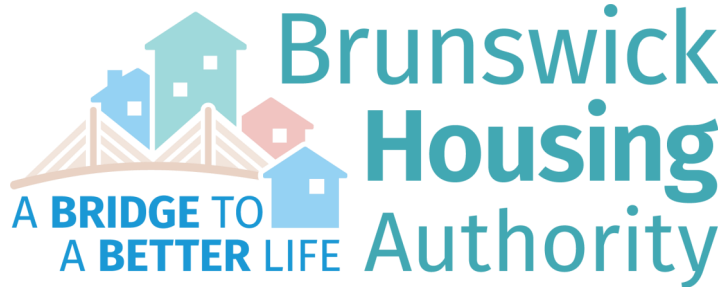

November marks the end of hurricane season and Alec Eaton, City of Brunswick EMA Coordinator updated the residents on the highlights of Hurricane Idalia preparations and processes that took place after Hurricane Idalia. Mr. Eaton stated that our emergency management team is not only for Hurricanes but, for all emergencies that involves emergency service assistance or notifications. He talked about the Pinova fire and how the EMA was able to cast emergency notifications to every cell phone in a specific area about the fire. Mr. Eaton explained the 5 phases of reentry. Whereas phase 4 was phase the residents a can reenter their homes and 5th phase is considered everyday operations. He concluded by informing the residents about emergency recovery services from the Small Business Association and the Lutheran Church. Mr. Eaton signed all of the residents up with CodeRed ,an emergency notification platform.
