

Aquashia joined Jobs Plus in August 2023, having secured part time employment just a week earlier at the "The Well Homeless Center". In her role as a transporter, she assisted clients with crucial appointments and ensured they received proper healthcare services.

Throughout her journey, Aquashia maintained consistent monthly contact with her Jobs Plus case manager, always eager to share her progress. During this time, she was also working towards her master's degree in social work, which she successfully completed in December 2023. Shortly thereafter, she gained her social work license and reported her new employment in February 2024.

Aquashia is now a licensed social worker, having been employed for over 90 days and quickly approaching her 180- day milestone, with 139 days of work to date. We are excited to share her story and appreciate everyone who has contributed to her success. We look forward to continuing our case management services for Aquashia, as we are also providing the rent incentive
